Share of Cost Notification

WHEREAS:

Many IHSS clients are required to pay a share of the cost of their IHSS services; and

WHEREAS:

Providers receive checks that cannot be redeemed for their previously worked hours. These checks that cannot be redeemed, are proof that the client acknowledges that services were provided and the provider is due payment.

WHEREAS:

The only way to resolve this issue outside of changing state payroll policy, is to go to small claims court which is ineffective and does nothing to address the cause of the problem.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That UDW/ASFSCME Local 3930 made it a priority to fight for the fair compensation of all IHSS providers, including ending the abusive conditions created by share of cost.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED;

That UDW/AFSCME Local 3930 calls on the State of California to direct IHSS payroll to notify each provider if they will be working for a client with a share of cost responsibility so the provider may be notified in time to make a decision regarding services rendered, prior to working for said client.
